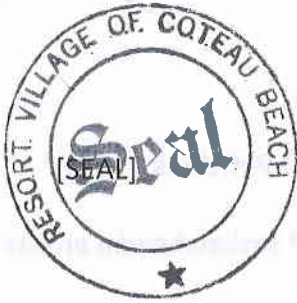


Resort Village of Coteau Beach
Bylaw No. 10/2020
A Bylaw to Satisfy the Requirements of Sufficient Petitions

The Council of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Tree Petitions bylaw".
2. Council received a petition on January 22, 2020 which was found to be sufficient on February 20, 2020 by Administrator Steven Piermantier. The question on the petition is as follows: Do you want a referendum vote to stop the removal of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach golf course trees growing along the property boundary line adjacent to Coteau Developments Inc. (CDI)?
3. Council received a petition on May 25, 2020 which was found to be sufficient on June 24, 2020 by Administrator Steven Piermantier. The question on the petition is as follows: Do you want a referendum vote to stop any trimming of trees, removal of trees, tree height restrictions, disturbance of soil around any existing trees within 150 feet of the boundaries of our golf course property bordering or in view from Coteau Developments Inc. (CDI)?
4. The Council of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach will not authorize the removal of any trees growing along the west boundary of the golf course property, immediately adjacent to the former Municipal Reserve lands included in the Coteau Developments Inc. subdivision. A map of the area is attached and forms part of this bylaw as Schedule I.
5. The Council of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach will not authorize anyone to trim or remove any trees from the golf course property until such time as:
 - a. Trimming of trees/shrubs is ONLY permitted for the preservation of a healthy landscape as is allowed with the prior approval of Council.
 - b. Removal of any tree/shrub is banned unless necessary for the health of the landscape and can only be done with prior approval of Council.
6. The Council of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach considers the passing of this bylaw to accord to the requirements of Section 136(5) of *The Municipalities Act* regarding the petitions referred to in Section 2 and Section 3 of this bylaw.

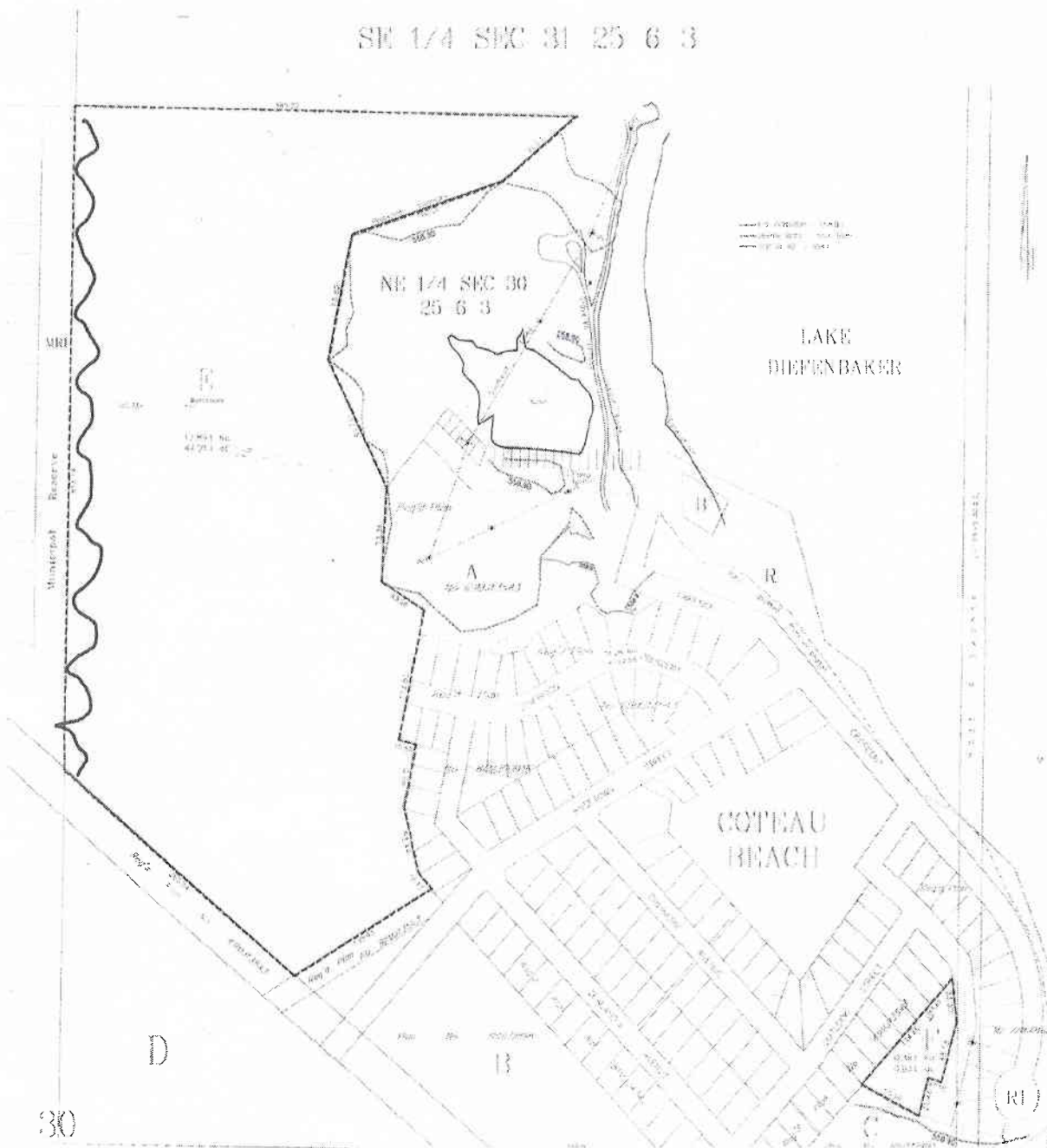
