

INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS – YOU CAN HELP

You will have noticed that a new sign has gone up at the entrance to our community. Our community has joined the LAKE DIEFENBAKER TASK FORCE against ZEBRA MUSSELS.

As members of the Task Force, we have agreed that every citizen will be on the alert for OUT-OF-PROVINCE VEHICLES towing or carrying any kind of watercraft (motorboat, pontoon boat, sailboat, canoe, kayak, sea doo, jet ski, etc.).

Once zebra mussels get into a lake, it is impossible to get rid of them. Zebra mussels will cause:

- a change in the type of fish in the lake,**
- a shoreline covered is razor sharp shells, no longer safe for walking on the beach without wearing rubber boots,**
- boat props and hulls that have to be scraped regularly to remove these mussels,**
- clogged water intakes for irrigation and domestic water,**
- a decrease in property values, and**
- a decline in tourism.**

If you spot an out-of-province vehicle in our community, (especially one with US or Manitoba plates), please call the driver's attention to the sign. Encourage the driver to phone the number on the sign. We have trained inspectors at three locations on the lake (Elbow, Sask Landing and Palliser) and access to decontamination equipment to make the boat safe.
