



**BYLAW 01-08  
RESORT VILLAGE OF COTEAU BEACH**



**A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES**

The Council of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
  - a) "public highway" means any street, land or public highway within the Village but does not include a Provincial highway therein as designated pursuant to the provisions of the "Highways and Transportation Act 1997"
  - b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning as describe to it by "The Traffic Safety Act "
  - c) "speed zone" means any portion of a public highway within the Resort Village of Coteau Beach as designated herein, and identified by a sign indicating the maximum speed applicable thereto
2. (1) Speed zones are hereby established within the Resort Village of Coteau Beach as 20 km in all locations
- (2) Subject to the Traffic Safety Act and to Section 2 Subsection (1) ® hereof, no person shall operate a motor vehicle on any public highway in any speed zone set out in Subsection 1 at a speed greater than that set out therein
3. Subject to the Traffic Safety Act and Section 2 hereof, no person shall operate a motor vehicle upon any portion of a public highway within the Resort Village of Coteau Beach to which Section 2 hereof is not applicable at a speed greater that 20 km per hour.
4. Nothing in Section 2 or 3 hereof shall be deemed to apply to the operators of fire engines, fire department apparatus or to vehicles being operated by law enforcement officers or to the operators of ambulances, where these vehicles are being operated in emergency duty and employing the siren and flashing lights.
5. Any person who violates any provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties as prescribed in the general penalty bylaw.
6. Bylaw No. 7 is hereby repealed.
