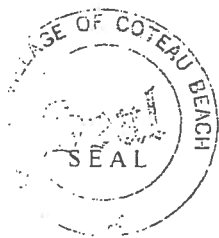



BYLAW 04/04
RESORT VILLAGE OF COTEAU BEACH


A BYLAW TO REGULATE ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES

The Council of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. In this bylaw, including this section:
 - (a) "all terrain vehicle" and/or "ATV" means all terrain vehicles as defined in The All Terrain Vehicle Act
 - (b) "highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act and includes a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designated and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area
 - (c) "private land" means land other than public land as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act
 - (d) "public land" means Crown land or any land vested in the municipality, as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act
 - (e) "vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in The Highway Traffic Act
2. No person shall operate an ATV on any Village owned or leased property within the corporate limits of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach, unless within the provisions of Section 4.
3. No person shall operate an ATV on any Crown Land which is within the Resort Village of Coteau Beach, unless within the provisions of Section 4.
4. A person is authorized to operate an all terrain vehicle within the corporate limits of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach, provided such person is of legal age, is a licensed vehicle operator, and is only traveling from the place of storage of the ATV directly to the beach area, or is involved in maintenance work for or on behalf of the Resort Village of Coteau Beach.
